Board in June 2003 and brings a wealth of hands-on experience in change management, employee development, and strategic planning. As a former Sr. Vice-President of Human Resources

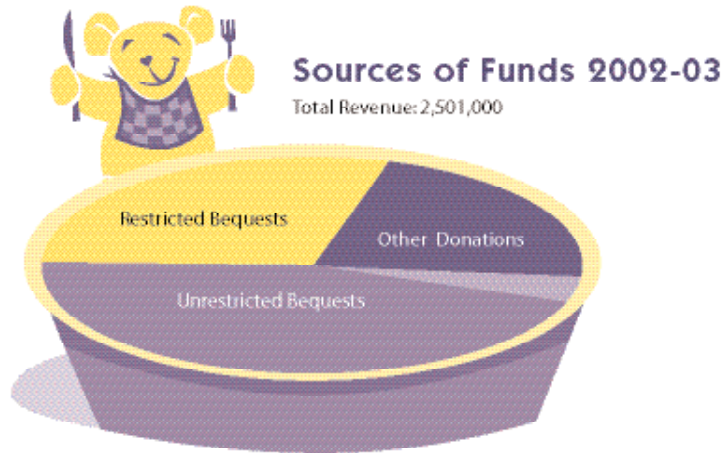
for Coast Capital Savings, Deborah integrated the human resource systems resulting in the successful merger of Pacific Coast Savings and Richmond Savings Credit Union.

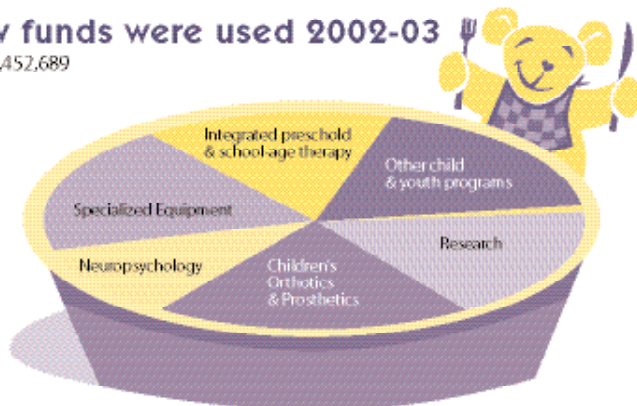

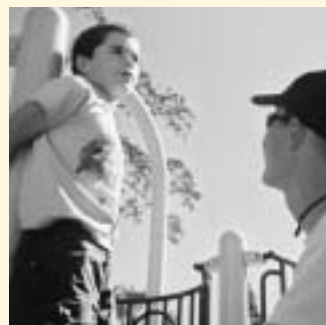
